Minutes of Annual Meeting
Sunday, August 14, 2016

Bill Weiler welcomed those in attendance and called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m. He introduced the directors present: Margie Weiler, Gay Sheary, Paula Falkowski and Ashley Geddes.

Paula Falkowski read the minutes of the Annual Meeting of August 2, 2015. The minutes were accepted as read.

Margie Weiler presented the Treasurer's Report, which showed for the fiscal year ending May 31, 2016 income of \$3,902.06, expenses of \$1,533.60, and a final balance of \$25,531.54.

Margie Weiler also presented the Membership Report. There are currently 30 Life Members, 16 Family, 18 Individual, and 7 Complimentary for a total of 71.

Bill Weiler asked Margie Weiler to present an amendment to the bylaws, which introduced a fifth "Family Life" category. The amendment passed.

Bill Weiler encouraged members to take more active roles in the Society.

Bill Weiler called for and received a motion to adjourn — all in favor.

Following the business meeting, Bill introduced the speaker, Paul Wainwright, who presented "New England Colonial Meetinghouses." Using photography of surviving meeting houses, Mr. Wainwright told the story of the society that built and used them and the lasting impact they have had on American culture. The presentation was in co-sponsored by the Center Meeting House and made possible with a grant from the N.H. Humanities Council.

Refreshments followed at the Vets Hall.
